




Bob Graham was born in Sydney in 1942. He studied drawing and painting at the Julian Ashton Art school and later travelled to the UK where he worked in a diverse range of jobs. His return to Sydney in 1969 marked the start of his career as an illustrator and designer. In 1983 he and his wife moved to a property in the Dandenongs near Melbourne and then in 1995 they returned to England where Bob is now working as a



full-time freelance illustrator. Over the years his many projects have included a six-page, monthly comic strip for a French magazine - Belles Histoires; illustrations for various commercial enterprises; and his first love, writing and illustrating children's books.

His books are well known for their simplicity and humour, told from children's perspectives, including "Oscar's Half Birthday," "Buffy," (Smarties Book prize silver award winner) and "Let's Get a Pup" (shortlisted for the 2002 Kate Greenaway medal; winner Boston Globe-Horn book award.) He won the 2000 Smarties Gold medal for "Max", the 2003 Kate Greenaway medal for "Jethro Byrde," and the Australian Children's Book of the Year Award four times. Other titles include "Queenie the Bantam," (highly commended for the Kate Greenaway medal,) "Dimity Dumpty" and "Brand New Baby." His book "How to Heal a Broken Wing," has won the Charlotte Zolotow award, shortlisted for the NSW Premier's Literary Award, and shortlisted for the 2009 Kate Greenaway medal.




