



Create Your Own 'Worlds Worst Child' Character

Write your own story about the worst child you can think of.


David Walliams uses alliteration for each of the children's names in the book, *Definition of alliteration: the repetition of usually initial consonant sounds in two or more neighbouring words or syllables (such as wild and woolly, threatening throngs)

- Start by thinking of the name of your character.
- Then think of another word starting with the same first letter to describe your character. See the character names/chapter titles from this book as examples: Terrible Triplets, Tandy's Tantrum, Boastful Barnabus, Fanny's Funny Faces, Hank's Pranks, Honey the Hogger, Vain Valentine, Bonnie Bossypants, Walter the Wasp and Kung Fu Kylie.
- Write your short story about a terrible thing your character did.
