Rhyming words are words that sound like each other when you say them out loud.

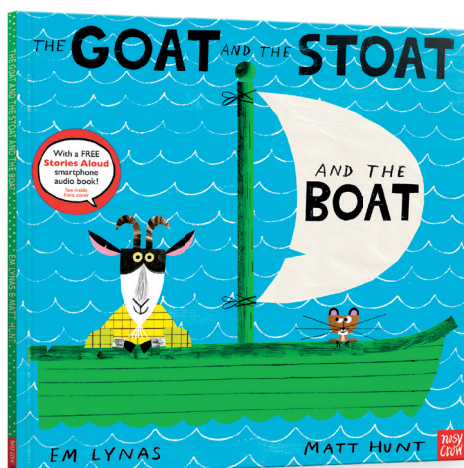
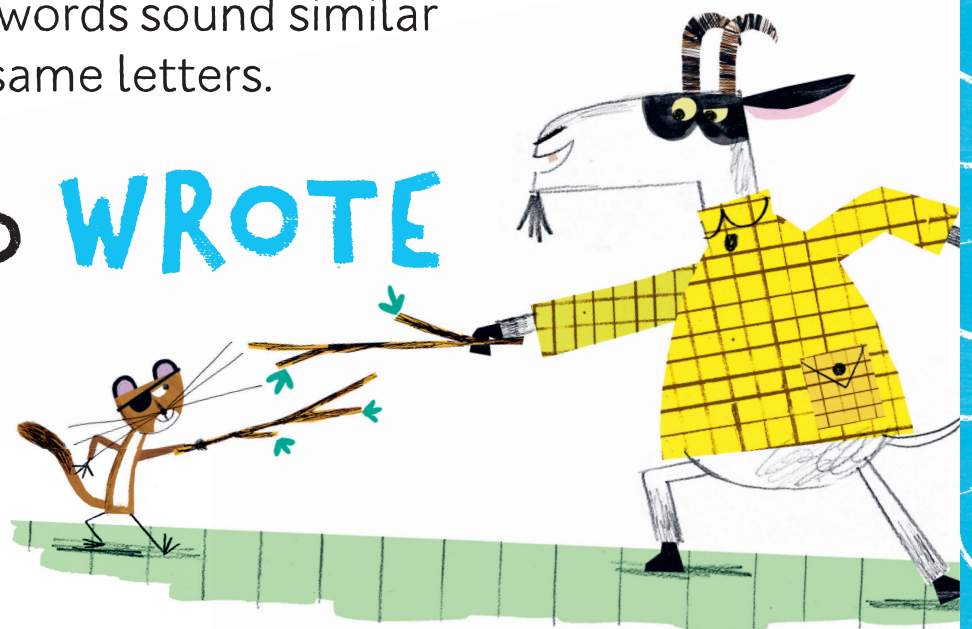
GOAT AND STOAT

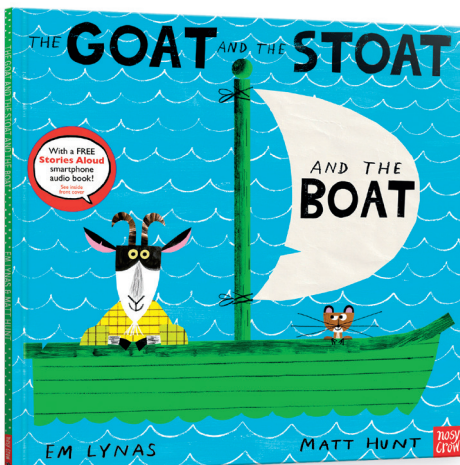


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DOES IT RHYME?

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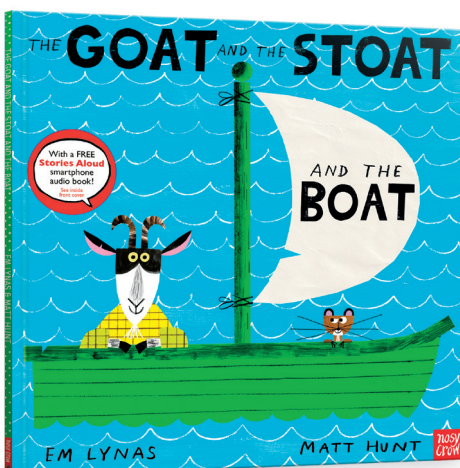
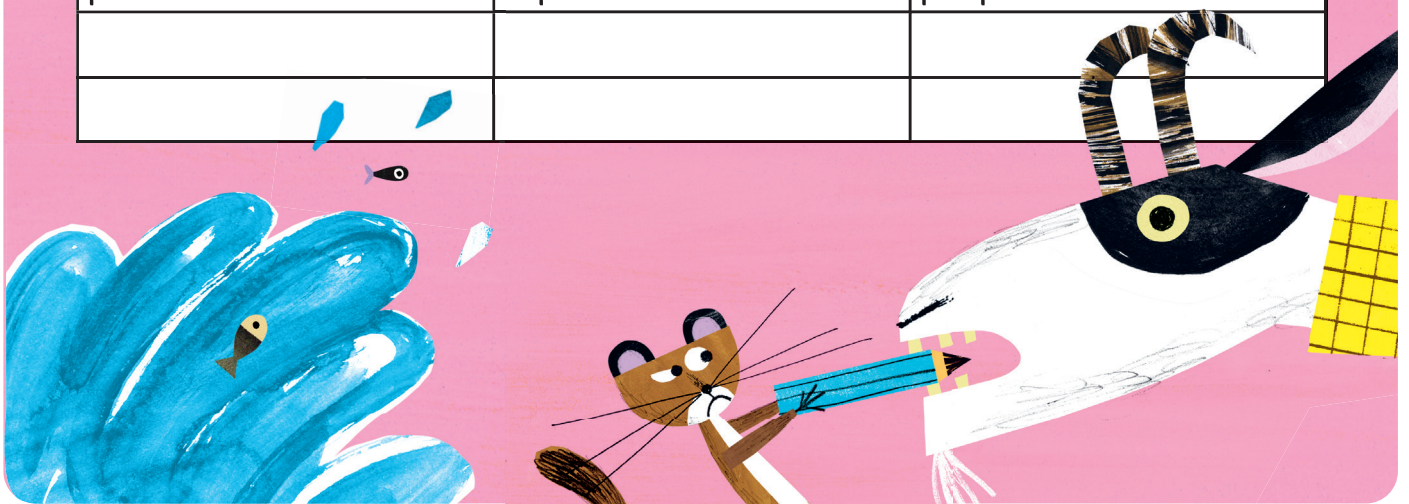
