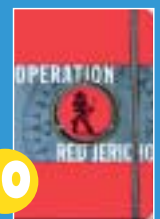
8. Horrible Histories: Loathsome London (Terry Deary) \$10.95

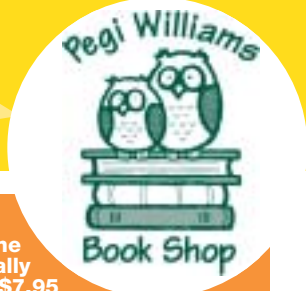
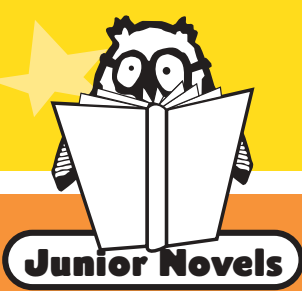
43. Walter the Farting Dog (William Kotzwinkle) \$14.95
