They were dead because Miranda had killed them. Olive Corbett is definitely not crazy. Not any more. These days she takes her meds like a good girl, hangs out with her best friend Ami, and stays the hell away from the toxic girls she used to be friends with. She doesn't need a boyfriend, and she doesn't need the drama of that creepy new girl Miranda trying to make it with her ex-friends. But then, against all odds, Miranda best-friends one of them and makes the others go away. As Miranda emerges from the shadows, Olive begins to realise something sinister is going on. Age 14+

#### 57. Tantony (Ananda Braxton-Smith)
