1. Aboriginal Stories - How the Birds Got Their Colours Big Book (Pamela Lofts)

\$39.99 \$33.99

This book is based on a story told by Mary Albert, of the Bardi people, to Aboriginal children living in Broome, Western Australia. The illustrations are adapted from their paintings of the story. Mary Albert said, 'Would you like to hear a story from long ago? My mother used to tell me lots of stories, but this story I loved the best, because I loved the birds.'

2. Aboriginal Stories - How the Kangaroos Got Their Tails Big Book (Pamela Lofts)

\$39.99 \$33.99

This book is based on a story told by George Mung Mung Lirrimiyarri, of the Kija people, to Aboriginal people living in Warmun (Turkey Creek), Western Australia. The illustrations are adapted from their original paintings of the story. Hector Jandany and George Dingmarie of the Kija Language Group said, 'We have to keep this language which we got from our old people who have passed away. We don't want to lose it. The younger generation has to carry on the language that they learn from us.'

3. Aboriginal Stories - Warnayarra, the Rainbow Snake Big Book (Pamela Lofts)

This story is based on a story told by the Senior Boys Class at Lajamanu School, a bilingual school where Aboriginal children are taught to read and write their own language, Walpiri. Illustrator Pamela Lofts adapted the illustrations from original paintings done by the children for their story.

4. Aboriginal Stories - When the Snake Bites the Sun Big Book (Pamela Lofts)

This book is based on a story told by David Mowaljarlai of the Ngarinyin people to Aboriginal children living in the Kimberleys, Western Australia. The illustrations are adapted from their paintings of the story. David Mowaljarlai said, 'We want our children to see the daylight and the sun go down on our land, the home of the Dreamtime, and to live there to their old age and really understand their culture.'

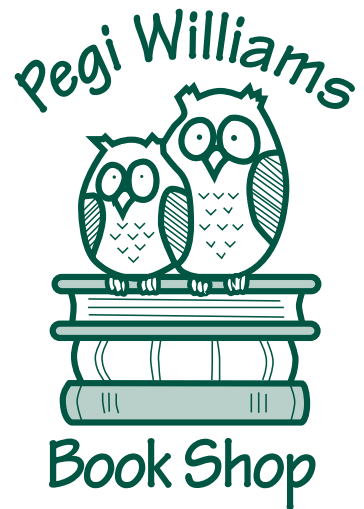

A broken, old bus appears one morning right outside Stella's house. On the front of it, held up with packing tape, is a hand painted sign... "Heaven". For Stella, this decrepit old vehicle is special - this bus is "ours" - a place for everyone to be together: hold meetings, play games and share stories. But one day, the bus is towed away and Stella must fight to save not just the bus, but everything the community has worked so hard to create.

19. Bush Bash (Sally Morgan and Ambelin Kwaymullina)

But Branch isn't exactly the pet of her dreams, and neither is Twig, Mr Round (a car tyre), or her baby brother Milo. Will Prudence ever find the perfect pet?

34. Queenie: One Elephant's Story (Corinne Fenton and Pete Gouldthorpe)

Reprinted. There was a time when for tuppence you could ride on the back of an elephant at a zoo. Queenie was one such elephant. Until her death in 1945, she patiently carried up to 500 people a day.
