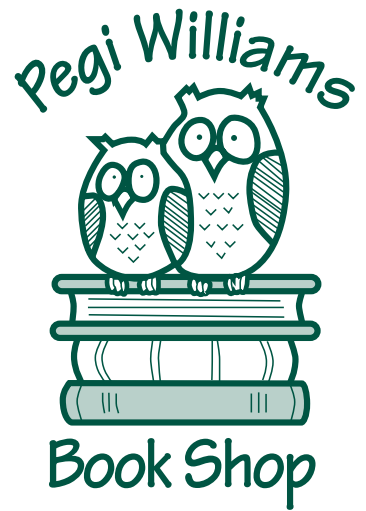

- 45. Once Tashi Met a Dragon (Anna Fienberg and Kim Gamble)** **\$24.99 \$22.50**
In this fabulous full-colour picture book, Tashi rides on a white tiger to the top of the mountain to see why the dragon is not sending the rains to his village.
- 46. Rainforest Lullaby (Sally Odgers and Lisa Stewart)** **\$24.99 \$22.50**
In the drowsing tropic scene, Tree frog's clinging green-on-green. Snuggled safe till the sun slips down, Ringtail Possum's sleeping sound. All the animals sleep soundly in the comfort of the rainforest.
