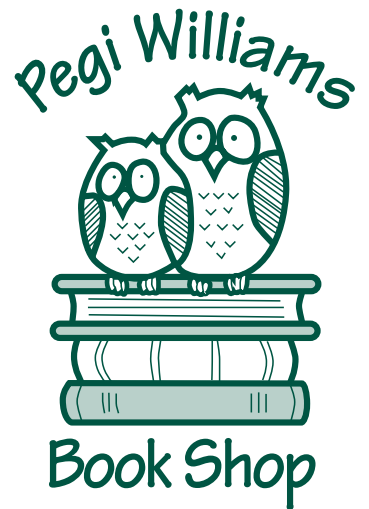

At first glance, this elegant alphabet book showcasing both upper and lowercase letters, seems to follow a familiar formula. There's an acrobat standing atop a horse to form a big letter A and another curled under herself to make a small one. There's a colony of beetles attached to the leaves they've munched, creating a big and a small letter B. But then comes the letter C, made of sea waves evoking the artist Hokusai. Ingenious and intriguing, beautiful and full of stunning detail, this is an alphabet book sure to invite many repeat explorations.
- 50. Armadillo in New York, An (Julie Kraulis)** **\$29.99 \$27.00**
When Arlo was born, his grandfather Augustin wrote travel journals about his favourite places for Arlo to use when he was old enough to go exploring on his own. When Arlo reads about New York and the mysterious Lady Liberty, he decides it's time for his next adventure. He travels to New York and, guided by Augustin's journal, discovers the joys of the city.
- 51. Ballad of Henry Hoplingsea, The (Julia Hubery)** **\$24.99 \$22.50**
Henry will do anything to win the hand of his beloved Carmelita. He is inventive and determined, and nothing is going to stand in his way. Except maybe a niggling feeling that something is not quite right. This is a rollicking tale about wanting what you have, rather than having what you want.
- 52. Bumblebear (Nadia Shireen)** **\$17.99 \$16.20**
There's a new bee at Bee School. But that bee is not a bee... It's a BEAR! Cheeky, sneaky Norman has a cunning plot to trick the bees and steal their honey. In his best bee onesie, Norman makes quite a convincing bee - but how long will his disguise last? And when the hive is endangered can he finally discover his true destiny and become The Bumblebear?
- 53. Captain Sneer the Buccaneer (Penny Morrison and Gabrielle Evans)** **\$24.99 \$22.50**
ARRR! Captain Sneer and his hardy crew of buccaneers are in for adventure - and a big surprise - in this rollicking rhyming treasure hunt. Ahoy there, me hearties! Meet CAPTAIN SNEER - a most boastful buccaneer! He's ROUGH and TOUGH. He's BRAVE and BOLD. He SAILS the SEAS in SEARCH of GOLD!
