11. An A - Z of Fairies (Caroline Stills and Heath McKenzie)

F is for the fairies in the pages of this book. You'll find them hiding everywhere - just go and have a look!

12. Barry (Colin Thompson)

\$24.95 \$22.46 Barry may be no larger than a can of beans, but his powers are awesome. The trouble is he has been trapped down the back of the sofa for over fifty years unable to do the job he was built for. His creators have gone back to their own planet and without his control the Earth is gradually falling apart. Can Barry emerge from the darkness and save the world before it is too late?

13. Ben and Duck (Sara Acton)

\$24.99 \$22.50

One day Ben decides to go to the park and feed the ducks. There he meets a particularly persuasive duck who follows him home. This is a delightfully illustrated and funny story about the development of a new relationship.

14. Bicycle, The (Colin Thompson)\$27.99 \$25.20
In September 2008, Colin Thompson visited Cambodia with Save the Children. Struck by the way the humble bicycle was central to so many people lives, he was inspired to create his second picture book for the organisation. 15. Bus Called Heaven, A (Bob Graham)


